Items included in the 1st Day School Supplies kit (6th grade: \$75.99, 7th grade: \$72.99, 8th grade: \$71.99):

- 3 pkgs. of 100 sheet 3x3 Post-It brand sticky notes
- 1 pkg. of 8 washable wide tip classic color markers
- 1 box of 12 colored pencils (sharpened)
- 2 pkg. of 100 ruled index cards 3x5 (7th grade only)
- 2 pkg. of 100 ruled index cards 4x6 (7th grade only)
- 1 pkg. of 4 EXPO dry-erase chisel tip markers assorted colors (6th grade only)
- 6 highlighters (multiple colors)
- 1 canister type pencil sharpener
- 4 red pens (8th grade only)
- 36 #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 6 pens (black or blue)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 1 large pencil pouch
- 4 washable glue sticks
- 4 plastic 2-pocket folders - yellow (ELA), red (social studies), green (religion)
- 1 purple plastic 2-pocket folder with prongs (science)
